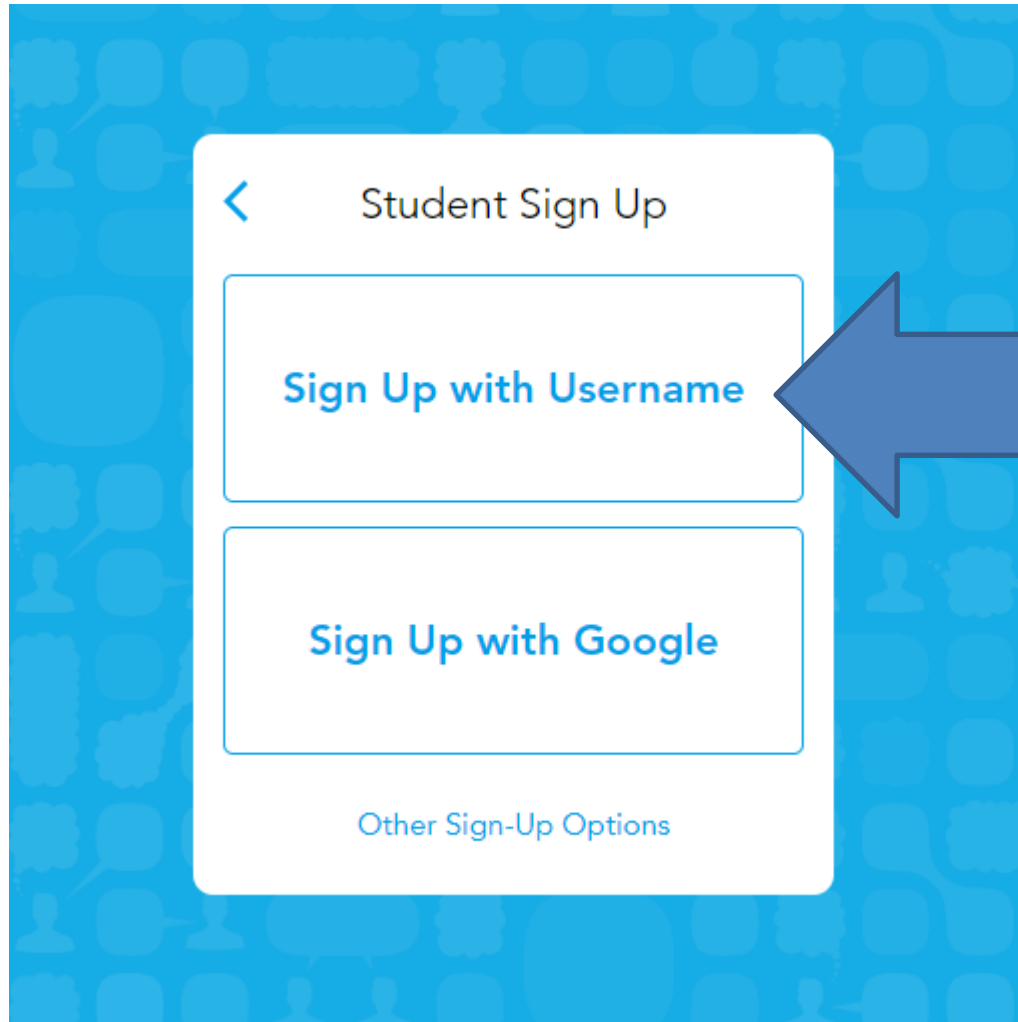

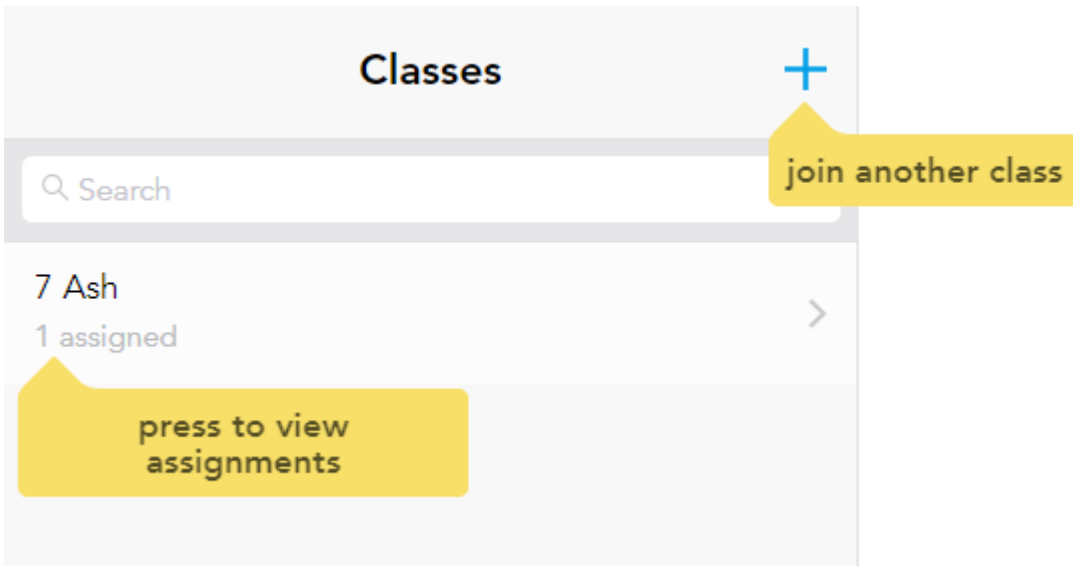

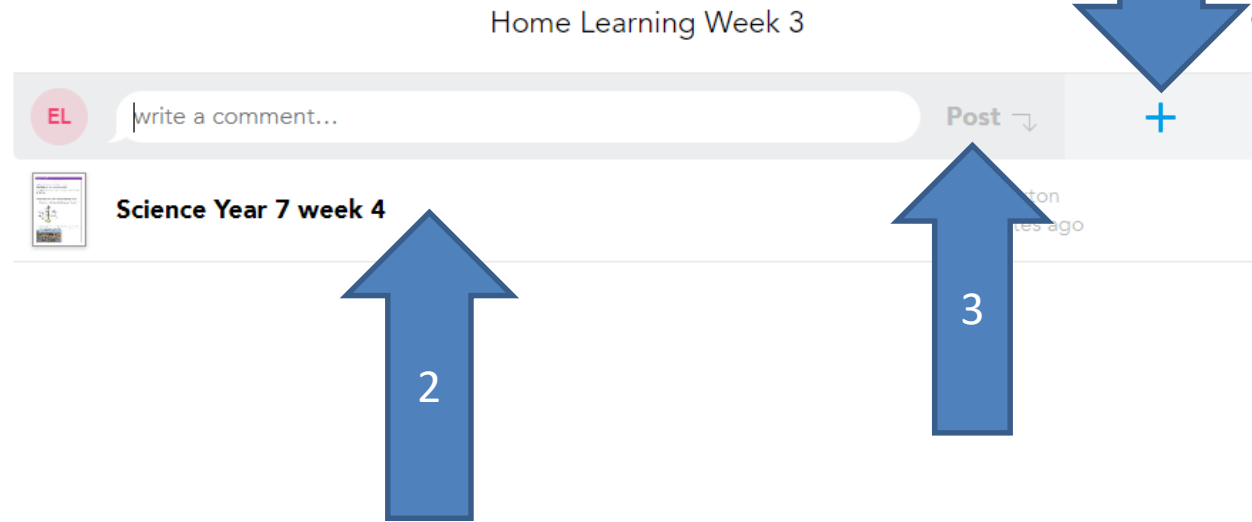
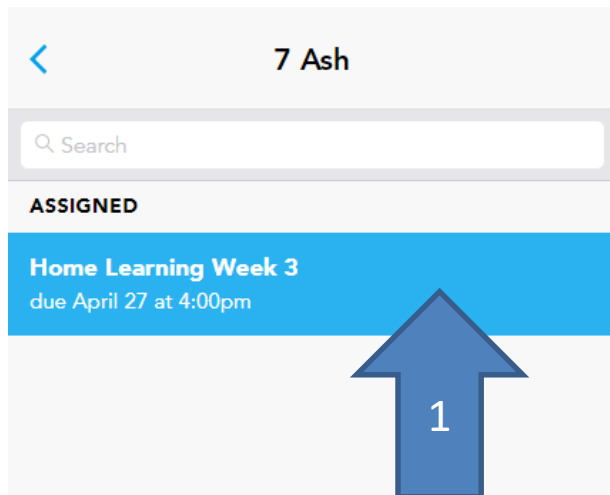
Join Class from Home Page

3. You can then view assignments set by your teacher and upload work

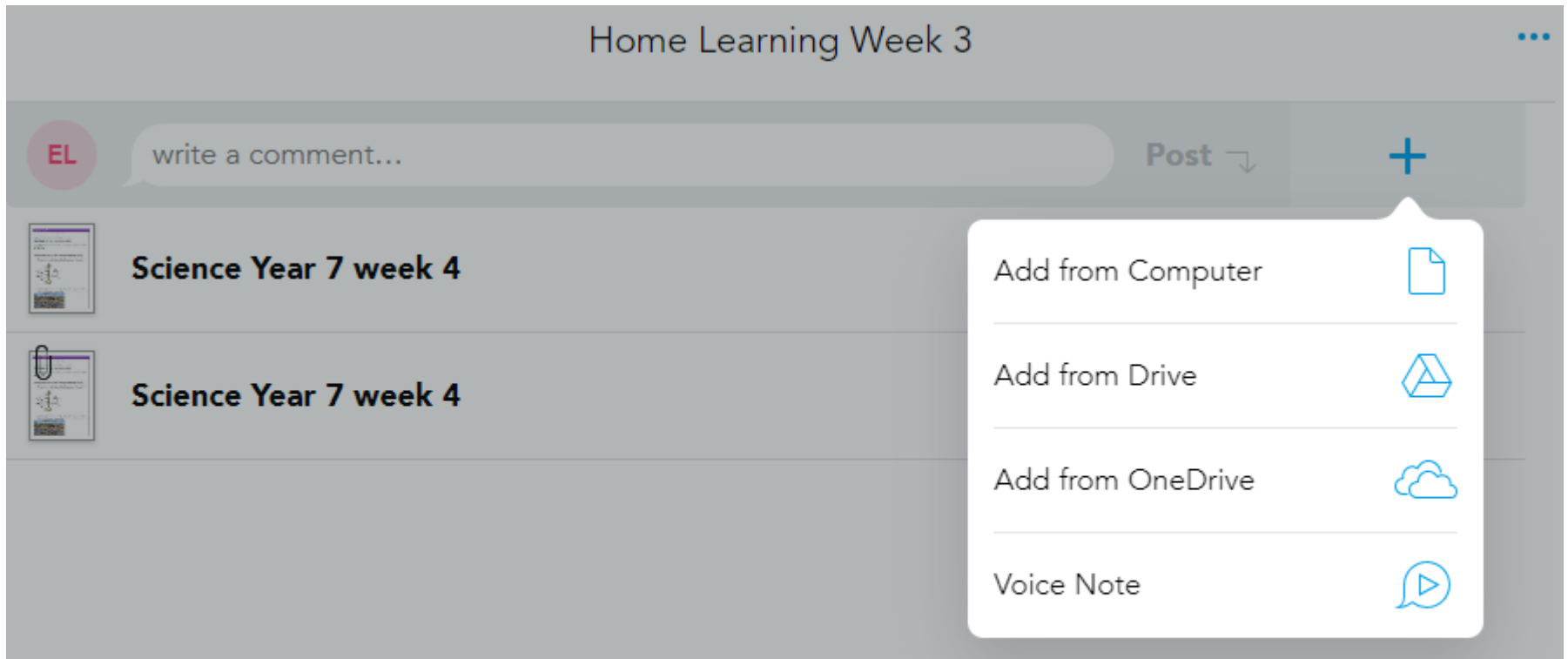
- Viewing and Completing Assignments

4. Attach files of completed work using the +



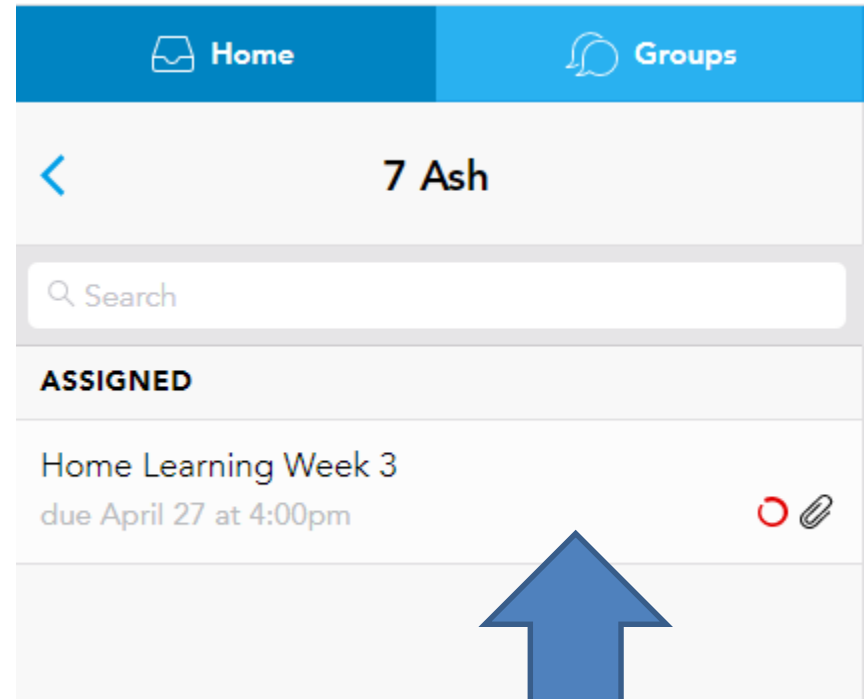
Upload work from computer
